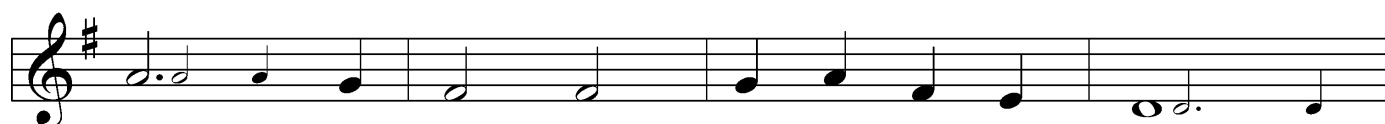

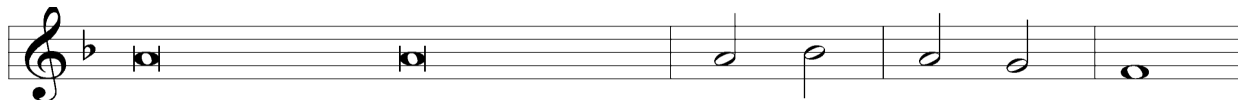

## FIRST LESSON

# ST. JOHN'S HEAT & AIR FUND

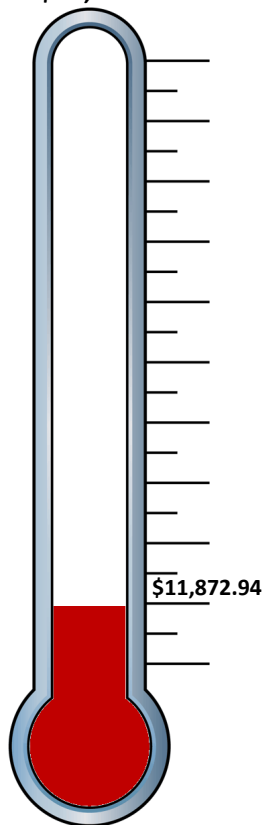
